Senior Success for Nicole

CSIS water skier Nicole Arthur from Slamannan, Falkirk won the European Under 21 Championships in Brescaï, Italy defeating 36 competitors from 17 countries. Nicole has also been competing against the worlds best senior female water skiers and has produced outstanding results. In Rocetto, Italy she took the bronze medal and followed this up by winning the Lena Cup in Switzerland just outside Geneva.

These results have put Nicole firmly onto the World and European Senior rankings. At world level she is now ranked 11 and at European level is ranked number 5. The British Senior Championships are her next target and then the big one, the World Senior Championships on 26th August in Linz, Austria.

As water skiing has very low prize money, Nicole is still an amateur. The CSIS has been assisting Nicole with sports medicine including physiotherapy, strength and conditioning, sports psychology and performance lifestyle. Still aged only 20 Nicole has a great future in the sport of water skiing and has her eyes firmly set on one day picking up the world champion trophy. A good marker for her will be the world under 21 championships which will take place in Santiago, Chile in January 2008.
